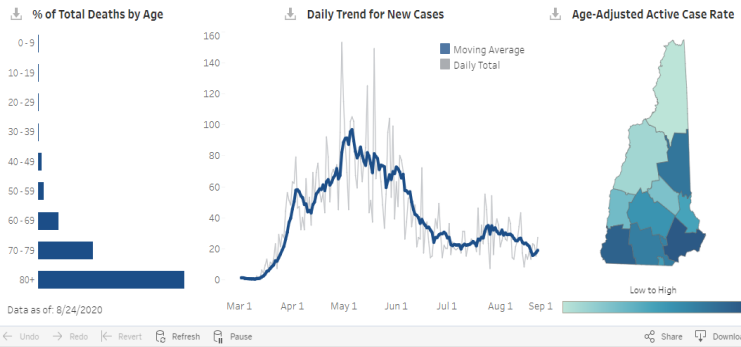


COVID-19 DASHBOARD 8/24/20

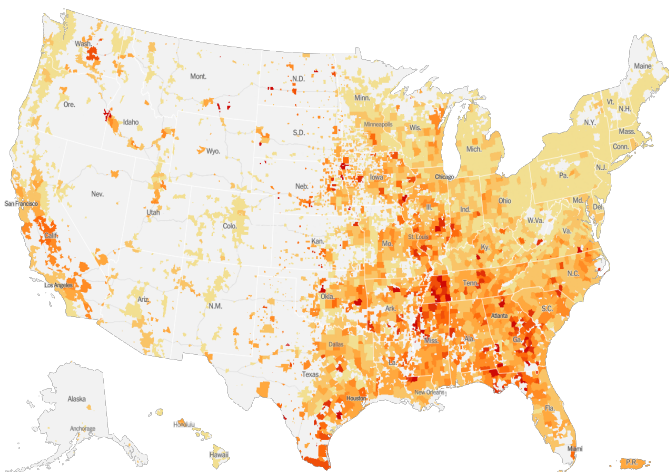
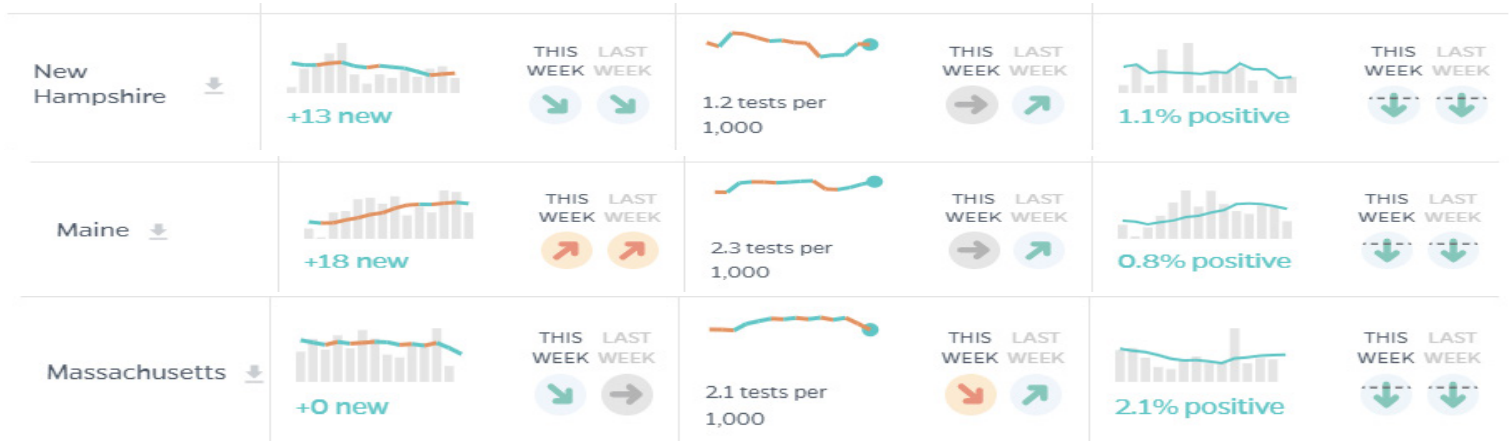

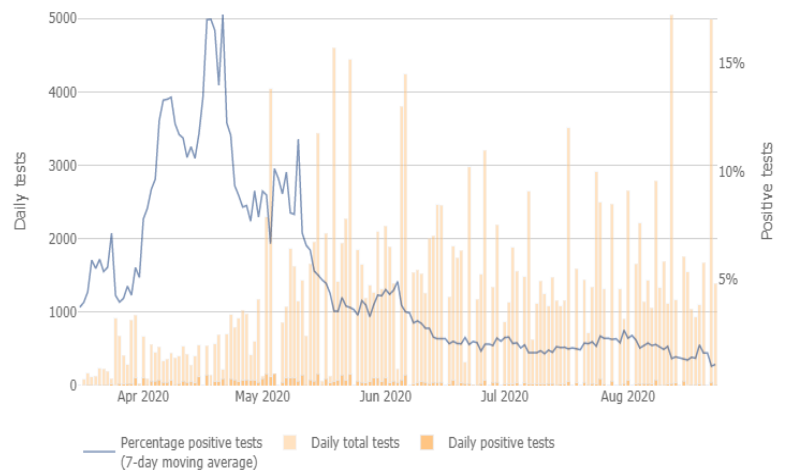
