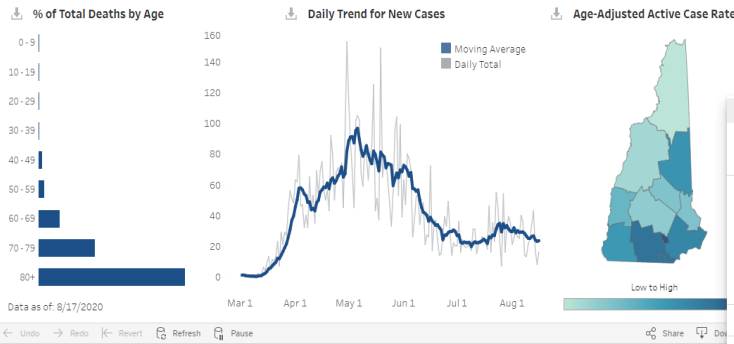


COVID-19 DASHBOARD 8/17/20

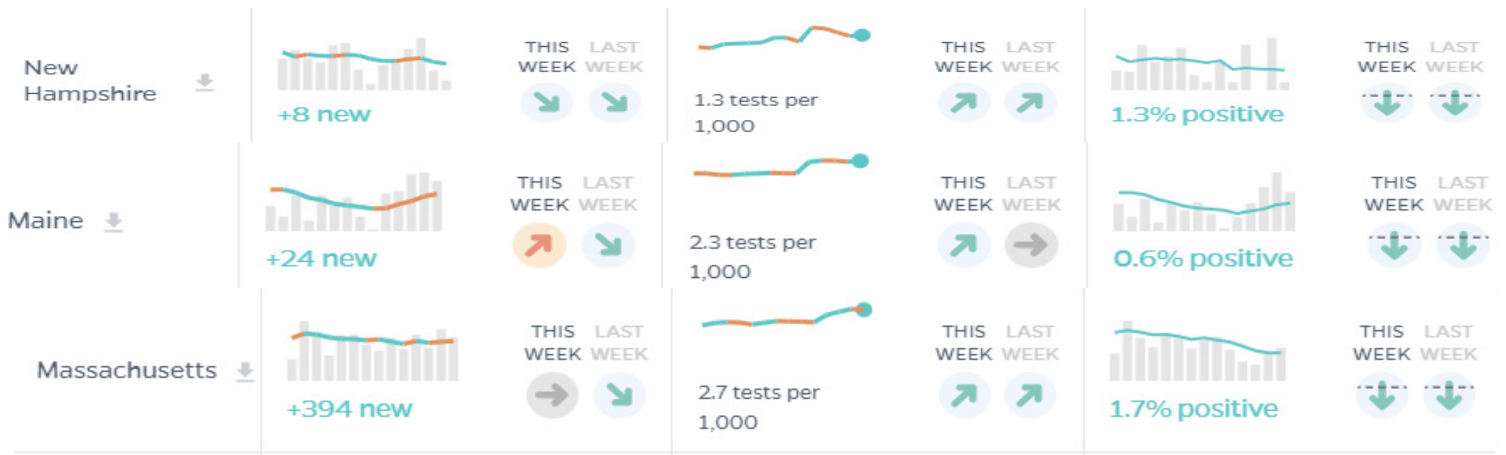

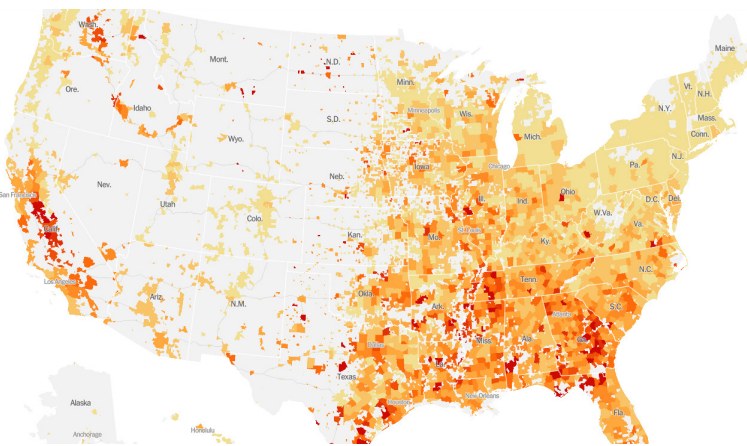
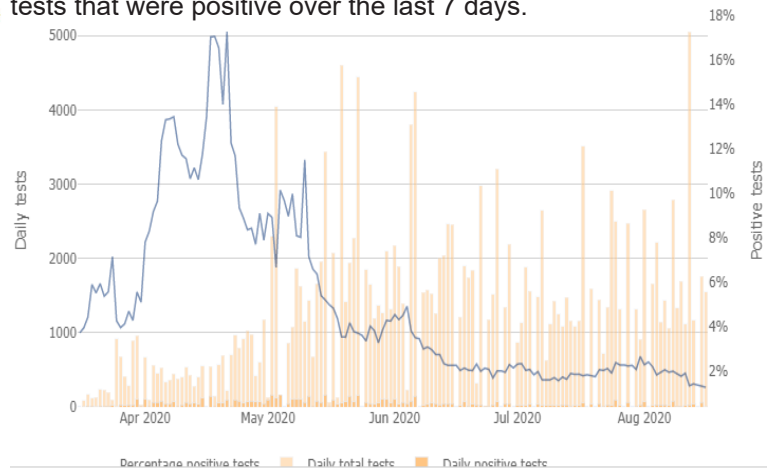
