


FIRST PUBLIC MEETING: WHAT WE HEARD


- Address the odor issues on

## PROPOSED ROADWAY TYPICAL SECTIONS







### ROADWAY & SIDEWALK LAYOUT














### STORMWATER MANAGEMENT

- Roadway grading & paving
- Curbing
- Water Quality "BMP's" (Best Management Practices)



### **UTILITY & DRAINAGE LAYOUT**







- Separated sewer and drain pipes
- · Larger sewer main (24" vs 15")
- Potential vent on discharge manhole at Lafayette Road
- Evaluate post-construction conditions
