





### **NEW IN 2023: TRIP CANCELLATION/ REFUND POLICY**

For all trips in 2023, refund requests must be submitted in writing (or email) and will be granted up until 2 weeks before the start of the program. Refunds are issued in the form of a check and usually take 2 to 3 weeks to process. If a request is made within two weeks prior to the start of the program, refunds will only be given for medical reasons or if the senior center is able to fill the spot with another participant.

For Royal Tours (Stacy Fenerty) Trips - we will be adhering to Royal Tours policy. If a person cancels and their space is filled with a replacement, they will be refunded. Otherwise, cancellations received within 30 days prior to the trip will <u>not be</u> refunded, unless they have purchased insurance, which guarantees a full refund, within 30 days after the trip.

For day trips with our Recreation Van - in the event of cancellation for any reason for the smaller amount fee day trips of \$5-\$10, we will credit your account for a future trip or program if you cannot attend.
