individuals with disabilities that they serve; and

Whereas: Direct Support Professionals are valued for their work in building respectful and

trusted relationships with individuals to assist them with their needs; and

Whereas: Direct Support Professionals provide essential support that ensures individuals

with disabilities are included as a valued part of their community; supported at home, at work, and in communities across New Hampshire; and empowered to

live with the dignity that all people of our City and state deserve; and

Whereas: An adequate workforce of high-quality Direct Support Professionals is necessary

for the people of New Hampshire to respond to the needs of people with

disabilities, and to avoid more costly institutional care.

Now, therefore, I, Deaglan McEachern, Mayor of the City of Portsmouth, on behalf of the members of the City Council and the citizens of Portsmouth, hereby proclaim that September 7 to 13, 2025 in Portsmouth is
