



Portsmouth offers an inclusive preschool program located at Little Harbour School. The Portsmouth Early Education Program (PEEP) supports 3-5 year old students with and without educational disabilities. We strive to create a respectful and compassionate learning community where all students are empowered to realize their potential in a challenging and supportive environment.

The PEEP classrooms offer a child-led learning approach with diverse, sensory, motor, and language-rich opportunities. Our thematic units are aligned with New Hampshire Early Learning Standards. Students will engage in a multitude of activities, including outdoor education, motor exploration, dramatic play, center-based learning, art and music activities, and creative free play.



A typical day at PEEP includes:

8:30 - 9:00 Outdoor Play
9:00 - 9:30 Morning Routines, Circle
9:30 - 10:15 Centers, Snack
10:15 - 11:15 Free Play
11:15 - 11:30 Closing Circle
11:30 - 12:00 Lunch
12:00 - 12:30 Outdoor Play

Sessions are **8:30AM-12:30PM Monday through Thursday.**

Two options for attendance are available:

4 days weekly for \$400 monthly
2 days weekly for \$200 monthly (Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday)

Parents/guardians must be able to provide transportation to/from each session. To enroll, students must be:

- 3-5 years old by September 30, 2026
- Toilet trained
- Current on NH required immunizations
